

The Nordic-Baltic countries to train and equip Ukrainian brigade

In a Joint Statement from February 2025 the Nordic-Baltic countries state we pledge to provide equipment and training for a scalable brigade-sized unit.

- **The Nordic-Baltic countries are pledging to support Ukraine by providing equipment and training for a scalable brigade-sized unit.**
- **Our aim is to provide substantial military equipment and training for such a unit already in 2025.**
- **The NB8 aim to contribute relevant brigade capabilities such as mechanized infantry materiel and logistical, medical and engineering assets, as well as munitions and spare parts.**
- **We are committed to achieve this through a combination of donations and procurement from Ukrainian industry partners.**
- **And just as important, we will provide military personnel for training and education.**
- **We will work closely with our Ukrainian partners and the NATO Security Assistance and Training for Ukraine (NSATU) moving forward.**
- **At the same time, we call upon allies and partners to provide more military support to Ukraine as well.**

The NB8 (Nordic–Baltic Eight) format comprises Denmark, Iceland, Norway, Finland, Sweden, Latvia, Lithuania and Estonia. Active cooperation between the Baltic and Nordic countries has been taking place since early 1990s.
