EU. Samferdselssaker og -møter uke 21/2021

- Det europeiske råd reagerer sterkt på Ryanair – hendelsen i Hviterussland. EASA publiserer sikkerhetsanbefaling om luftfartsoperasjoner i hviterussisk luftrom

Ryanair-episoden

Det europeiske Råd presenterte sine konklusjoner 24. mai, der de “strongly condemns” både den tvungne landingen av Ryanair-flyet i Minsk og fengslingen av Raman Pratasevich and Sofia Sapega. Det europeiske Råd oppfordrer bl.a. ICAO til å “urgently investigate this unprecedented and unacceptable incident» og om å unngå flyginger over Hviterussland. Rådet oppfordres videre om å vedta tilstrekkelige tiltak for å hindre hviterussiske flyselskaper i å overfly europeisk territorium og å lande på europeiske lufthavner. Transportkommisæren kommenterer på twitter kan finnes her. Saken forventes å komme opp på Transportministtermøtet 3. juni.

EUs flysikkerhetsbyrå (EASA) informerer i [pressemelding 26. mai](#) om at byrået har utstedt en sikkerhetsanbefaling om luftfartsoperasjoner i hviterussisk luftrom. EASA anbefaler at flyselskaper unngår flyinger i Flight Information Region – Minsk og å lande på Minsk lufthavn.

Vaksinepass

Rådet informerte i [pressemelding 21. mai](#) om at rådsorganet COREPER hadde gitt tilslutning til den politiske enigheten med Europaparlamentet 20. mai om digitale vaksinepass. I pressemeldingen fremgår det at vaksinepasset skal være i bruk fra 1. juni. EP forventes nå å gi sin formelle godkjenning på plenumsmøtet 7.-10. juni. Deretter må Rådet gi sin godkjenning, før loven kan signeres og publiseres i EU Official Journal.

Få av de europeiske transportorganisasjonene har ennå kommentert kompromisset. International Road Union (IRU) gikk imidlertid ut i [pressemelding 17. mai](#), med en oppfordring om at «World Health Organization and national governments to introduce urgently a global mutually recognised digital vaccination certificate for commercial truck and coach drivers.”. IRU oppfordrer her også nasjonale myndigheter om å prioritere vaksine til yrkessjåfører.

Transportministermøtet

Transportministermøtet vil finne sted i Luxembourg 3. juni. Møtet vil være fysisk, noe som innebærer at formelle beslutninger kan gjøres på møtet. [Agendaen](#) til møtet er nå også klar.

Sentrale lovsaker vil bli en (mulig) felles posisjon på forslagene på Single European Sky 2+, på [revisjon av direktivet om leide kjøretøy](#) og på [gjensidig godkjenning av sertifikater fra tredjeland](#) (for å kunne føre fartøy på innenlandske vannveier). Det knytter seg spenning til om man vil nå en felles posisjon på SES 2+. Det vil nok bli mer klart etter dagens COREPER-møte.

Andre sentrale saker vil være vedtagelse av rådskonklusjoner på jernbane "Putting rail at the forefront of smart and sustainable mobility" og (mulig) rådskonklusjoner på mobilitetsstrategien "Sustainable and smart mobility strategy — the way forward". På sistnevnte sak vil transportministrene også gjennomføre en [meningsutveksling på møtet](#). Denne vil ta utgangspunkt i følgende spørsmål:

- What other or additional actions or measures would deserve focus so as to achieve the objective of a more sustainable, smarter and more resilient transport and mobility system?
- Given that achieving this policy objective is conditional to the availability of the appropriate volume of resources (including financial resources), how can it be best ensured that the necessary resources are geared towards the transition to a more sustainable, smarter and more resilient system?

Hva gjelder andre saker, utover Ryanair-hendelsen, vil det bli gitt en oppdatering på status for trilogforhandlingene på revisjon av Eurovignette-direktivet, en oppdatering på elektroniske Passenger Locator Form (ePLF) – prosjektet, en informasjon om C-ITS roadshow i Brno 4. juni, en presentasjon om status for "Platform on International Rail Passenger Transport (IRP)", på initiativet for å forhindre tap av containere fra skip, på luftfartsforbindelser og gjenoppbygging av luftfartssektoren post covid 19 pandemien samt på det påtroppende slovenske formannskapets prioriteringer.

Merk avslutningsvis det danske dokumentet 19. mai til Transportministtermøtet om «Transition to zero-emission light-duty vehicles», der Danmark mf. oppfordrer Kommisjonen til å fastsette en felleseuropeisk utfasingsdato for salg av nye lette kjøretøy med forbrenningsmotorer.

Nye avgjørelser på statsstøtte – luftfart mv.

Retten presenterte 19. mai fire nye avgjørelser relatert til statsstøtte på luftfartsområde. Tre av sakene er relatert til støtte gitt under covid-19 pandemien. De covid 19 - relaterte avgjørelsene omfatter nederlandsk statsstøtte på 3,4 mrd. euro til flyselskapet KLM, portugisisk støtte på 1,2 mrd. euro til flyselskapet TAP og den spanske støtteordningen på 10 mrd. euro til strategisk viktige selskaper som sådan. Det er Ryanair som brakte alle disse sakene inn for Retten, som føyer seg inn i rekken med saker som Ryanair har klaget inn. Enkelte av disse har allerede fått en (foreløpig) avgjørelse, se Ryanair v Kommisjonen (om støtte til Finnair I) og Ryanair v Kommisjonen (om støtte til SAS) 14. april 2021. Andre saker, som bl.a. Kommisjonens godkjenning av Tysklands støtte til Lufthansa (9 mrd. euro) og lån til Condor (550 mill. euro) forventes det avgjørelser på nå i juni. KLM- og TAP-avgjørelsen markerer de to første avgjørelsene der Ryanair har fått medhold. Retten viser i disse sakene hhv. til «inadequate reasoning» og «inadequate statement of reasons» fra Kommisjonens side. I den spanske saken slår Retten fast at støtten er proporsjonal og ikke-diskriminerende, og dermed i tråd med EU-retten. Pressemelding på de tre sakene kan finnes her: Ryanair v Kommisjonen (om støtte til KLM), Ryanair v Kommisjonen (om støtte til TAP), og Ryanair v Kommisjonen (om spansk støtte).

Den fjerde saken omhandler statsstøtte fra den tyske delstaten Rheinland-Pfalz for å dekke økonomisk tap på Frankfurt - Hahn lufthavn opp til 25,3 mill. euro 2017-2021. Retten kom her til at støtten feilaktig ble godkjent av Kommisjonen i 2017, siden man ikke i tilstrekkelig grad hadde undersøkt om støtten var i tråd med regelverket. Det var Lufthansa som klaget inn denne saken, med begrunnelse om at støtten ville kunne forstyrre konkurransen i markedet da støtten i realiteten gikk videre til flyselskap som Ryanair. Avgjørelsen på siste sak følger her.

Avgjørelser fra Retten kan ankes til Domstolen.

EU-domstolens årsrapport 2020 er nå publisert. Den gir en god oversikt over domstolens aktivitet, også på transportområdet (se bl.a. eget avsnitt om lufttransport s. 38). Rapporten kan finnes [her](#).

Melding om blå økonomi

Kommisjonen presenterte 17. mai en [melding](#) «on a new approach for a sustainable blue economy in the EU. Transforming the EU's Blue Economy for a Sustainable Future». Den understreker bl.a. havnenes betydning og at også havnene må utvikle seg i takt med industrien for øvrig. Et tema som også Den europeiske havneorganisasjonen (ESPO) har tatt opp i punkt 2 – «The changing role of ports» i sitt [høringssvar](#) fra april 2021 til Kommisjonens konsultasjon på revisjon av TEN-T retningslinjene.

Kommisjonen varsler i meldingen om at man bl.a. vil etablere et “Blue Forum” for å koordinere for dialog mellom ulike aktører innenfor bl.a. fiskeri, skipsfart, turisme og fornybar energi for å skape synergier og for å redusere mulige konflikter knyttet til bruk av havet. Kommisjonen varsler også at man ønsker å bruke EU-midler til maritim transport a) gjennom fremme av nærskipfarten 2) renovering og modernisering av EUs skipsfartsflåte – med fokus på energieffektivisering og 3) utvikling av EUs maritime industri. Det nye fondet European Maritime, Aquaculture and Fisheries Fund skal også brukes til å støtte fiskeflåten med renere motorer og teknologi, så frem moderniseringen ikke fører til overkapasitet og eller -fisking. Kommisjonen varsler også at man vil følge opp målsetningen om nullutslippshavner, bl.a. gjennom [European Ports Forum](#) for deling og promotering av beste praksis og «bottom-up»-initiativ om grønnere havnetjenester. Kommisjonen vil også støtte medlemslandene, gjennom den styrkede Union Civil Protection Mechanism and EUs maritime byrå (EMSA) arbeid for å forberede og respondere til forurensningsulykker.

Den europeiske skipsrederforeningen ønsker i sin [pressemelding](#) 18. mai Kommisjonens melding velkommen.

Merk for øvrig at Rådet planlegger å vedta [rådskonklusjoner “on a sustainable blue economy: health, knowledge, prosperity, social equity”](#) på Landbruks- og fiskeriministtermøtet 26.-27 mai. Utkast til rådskonklusjoner ble godkjent på arbeidsgruppenivå før Kommisjonen presenterte sin melding 17. mai. Utkastet inneholder også omtale av havner. I rådskonklusjonene, i punkt 38, understrekes “... the need to ensure adequate funding and the framework conditions to promote research and development for efficient and innovative technologies to further prepare ships, ports, shipping activities, shipbuilding and energy production industries to support climate neutral and low-environmental-impact maritime transport activities” og i punkt 49 at “... seaports are fundamental to the blue economy; they are essential nodes in the development and operations of various blue economy sectors, from maritime transport to coastal and maritime tourism, from offshore energy, fishing and aquaculture, and shipbuilding, repair and recycling facilities to the maritime circular economy;”.

Handlingsplan for et giftfritt miljø

Kommisjonen presenterte 12. mai sin handlingsplan for et giftfritt miljø. Målsetningen med denne handlingsplanen er å eliminere all skadelig forurensning innen 2050. Planen er en del av EUs grønne giv. Kommisjonen viser her bl.a. at 400 000 personer dør for tidlig hvert år som følge av luftforurensning i Europa og at man på den bakgrunn vil foreslå at EUs luftkvalitetsstandarder blir tilpasset de kommende anbefalinger fra Verdens helseorganisasjon (WHO).

På transportområdet vises det til Mobilitetsstrategien, som ble presentert 9. desember 2021, der det varsles tiltak for å bekjempe luft- og støyforurensningen. Den kommende revisjon av Euro-standardene for kjøretøy gjentas her, inkludert at man vil vurdere å krav til reduserte utslipp av PM 2,5 og nanopartikler fra alle forbrenningsmotorer og bilbremseser. Kommisjonen mener også at arbeidet med å redusere støyforurensning må bedre integreres i byenes mobilitetsplaner. Dette vil nok trolig også bli adressert i kommende revisjon av bymobilitetspakken (2013).

EUs forskningsprogram Horizon Europe, som har flere såkalte «missions» og partnerskap, nevnes også i meldingen. «Zero emission waterborne transport» (ZEWT), «Towards zero-emission road transport» (ZZERO) og «Inland Navigation Action Plan 2021-2027» (NAIADES III) nevnes her særskilt.
