Note from the Secretariat of 19 October 2011

I. Main Conclusions

At its 328th meeting, the main conclusions drawn by the Administrative Commission were the following:

SUBJECT	Decision taken
Minutes of the 326th, 327th meetings and of the Working Party of 14 April 2011	They were approved.
EESSI- Approval of the SEDs resulting from the review by the Ad Hoc Groups	The SEDs were approved for testing purposes. As regards the third version of the SEDs, which aims at aligning business and IT requirements: - the mandate of the Ad Hoc groups is extended to ensure continuity and quality in the delivery of the final SEDs - Member States should have sufficient time to review version 3 of the SEDs. Member States will be asked to perform linguistic review only as regards version 3 of the SEDs.
EESSI - extension of the transitional period (Decision E3)	Decision E3 was approved: the transitional periods referred to in Article 95 (1) of Regulation (EC) No 987/2009 are extended by 24 months until 30 April 2014.
Reappointment of the current Chair of the Conciliation Board	Mr. Bruno DE PAUWE was reappointed as Chair of the Conciliation Board.
Translation costs 2010	They were approved.

Mandate and appointment of members to the Ad Hoc Group on a new edition of a document for the exchange of medical information	The mandate and appointment of the members of the Ad Hoc Group were approved, as presented in Note 376/11REV3.
Mandate and appointment of members of the Ad Hoc Group on the child-raising periods	The mandate and appointment of the members of the Ad Hoc Group were approved as presented in Note 346/11REV2.
