







Working Together for a Green, Competitive and Inclusive Europe

EUR 37.7 million has been allocated to a number of cooperation programmes with Slovenia through the EEA and Norway Grants (2014-2021). These programmes are designed to strengthen cooperation between Norway and Slovenia and to contribute to social and economic development in Slovenia.

Programmes in the field of climate and environment are at the heart of this cooperation, with emphasis on climate change adaptation, renewable energy and energy efficiency. Education is also a key priority, with focus on grants schemes, professional development of teachers and cooperation between educational insitutions and the business sector.

Three Norwegian agencies are involved as partners in developing and implementing the programmes in Slovenia, and to assist with the recruitment of Norwegian project partners.

THE EEA AND NORWAY GRANTS

The EEA and Norway Grants are linked to the EEA Agreement. Under the EEA Agreement, Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway are part of the EU's internal market. The EEA Agreement sets out the common goal of working together to reduce social and economic disparities in Europe and strengthen cooperation between donor and beneficiary countries. Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway have allocated EUR 2.8 billion to 15 EU countries for this purpose over a period of seven years. Norway provides just under 98 % of this amount.

The EEA and Norway Grants are an important tool in the Norwegian Government's active European policy, which seeks to promote a green, competitive and inclusive Europe.

Since becoming a member of the EU in 2004, Slovenia has received funding under the EEA and Norway Grants scheme as follows:
