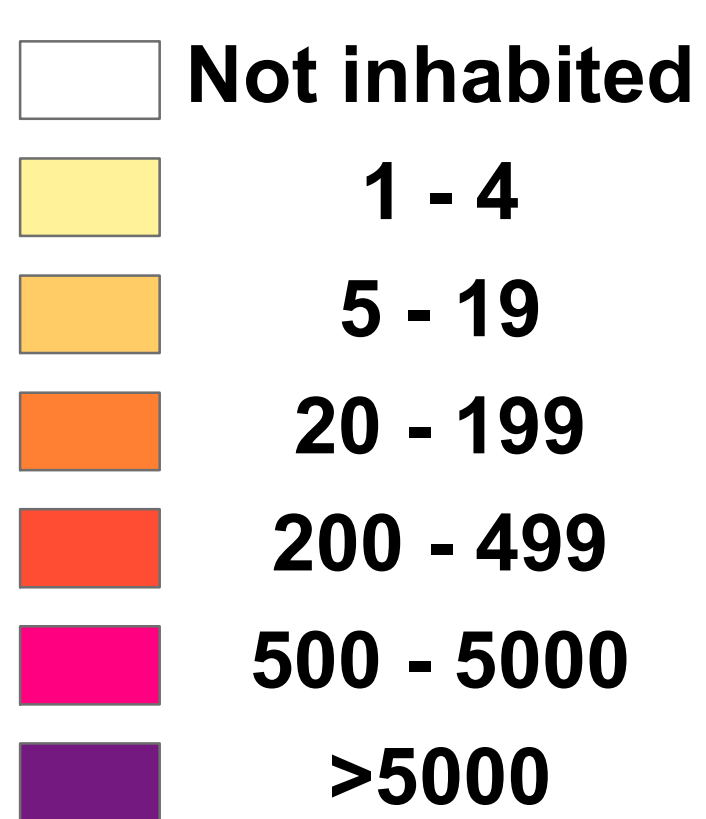


## Total residential population per km<sup>2</sup>
